## Your options after Year 11



## School Leaving Age

Students leave school on the last Friday in June (27<sup>th</sup>) at the end of the Year 11.

They must then participate in one of the following until they are 18:

- Stay in full-time education;
- Start an apprenticeship or training; or
- Spend 20 hours or more a week working or volunteering, while in part-time education or training.

## What counts as participating?

**REMEMBER**: You must be participating until you're 18.

#### Sixth form

Tuesday 12th November SGS Sixth Form Open Evening

- Entry requirements are set by individual schools
- Every school will have a different offer so have a look at multiple places

- Schools do not have to offer you a sixth form place
- You will most likely study multiple subjects
- St George's 6<sup>th</sup> form requires
   Grade 5's in most subjects

TIP: Apply for multiple places and keep all options open.

### College

- Colleges will set various entry requirements depending on the course
- We recommend applying for more than one course or college

- You will most likely focus on one subject
- College can offer a more practical learning environment - with a work placement

**TIP**: Visit as many places as possible by going to open days.







### **Apprenticeships**

- A full-time job (minimum of 30 hours per week)
- 80% working 20% Training
- From Level 2- Level 7



- Minimum wage is £6.40 per hour.
- English and Maths grade 4+ is important if you want to do an apprenticeship.



**TIP**: Apprenticeships are competitive – so you will need to apply for as many as possible.

## **Apprenticeships**

- On the job training studying at the same time
- You will Earn whilst you learn
- Equivalent to GCSEs, A levels and then degrees and Master Degrees
- > The cost of your training is ALWAYS covered by employer and government
- You get paid holiday and sick leave and other benefits!



## **Apprenticeship levels**




Apprenticeship Type	Level	Equivalent educational level
Intermediate	2	5 GCSE's A*-C (grades 9-4)
Advanced	3	2 A-Level Passes
Higher	4, 5	Higher education certificate/ Diploma or a foundation degree
Degree	6 7	Bachelor's degree Master's degree

## Apprenticeship Requirements


- Most Apprenticeships require Maths and English at Grade 4 or above
- Some will take with Grade 2 but these are very limited.

## How to Get an Apprenticeship



#### Grade Requirements for Post 16 courses

- Minimum Grade requirements are set by the Exam boards
- These is to ensure that the students can access the course and be successful
- A level courses normally require minimum Grade 5 in Maths and English plus 3 other GCSEs at Grade 5
- BTec level 3 and T level courses normally require minimum Grade 4 in Maths and English plus 3 other GCSEs at Grade 5
- If you are not **predicted** to achieve the grades required, then **you will not get an offer for a course**. This is sometimes called a "waiting list"
- It is important to achieve the grades in your course offer otherwise you will not be able to start the course.
- Level 2 courses are available at colleges, NTC, Thamesview, NSFG and St John's Most courses require a grade 2 in English and Maths as a minimum






